Items Discussed

This was the first meeting of the Tarbolton Community Council (TCC) since 2020, owing to COVID restrictions.

Discussions took place with regards to the following matters however no decisions were taken at the meeting:

- 1. SEPA and the current situation regarding the landfill site;
- 2. The situation regarding the Tarbolton Tenants Residents Association (TTRA);
- 3. Amenities in the village and future maintenance;



- 4. Village funding with regards to amenities, childrens' swing parks etc and the disparity between certain villages in regards to funding;
- 5. Concerns about the state of the old church yard after completion of the building works:
- 6. Concerns about the current state of the old town house and the face that the youths are gaining access to the building;
- 7. The ongoing situation regarding litter and discarded food products outside the Bombay Blue Takeaway;
- 8. The issue of vehicles parking in pavements, particularly on Burns Street and Cunningham Street, outside the Crown, resulting on people having to walk on road;
- 9. A complaint received by Jean McColm by a resident regarding children playing ball games in an area where there is a sign banning the same;
- 10. Concern about the state of the path crossing the park at Gallowhill Avenue, particularly flooding. Also, the trees overgrowing the children's play area equipment, which is getting covered in bird droppings;

The council were proud to note that Tarbolton war Memorial had received recognition form the Royal British Legion as a 2021 winner in the Best Kept War Memorial awards in the 'Small memorials without gardens' category. The council congratulated Cathy Thompson and her team of volunteers for the work achieving this award.
