Elected Members report

Cllr Dettbarn advised that she had enquired about the works at the Church graveyard to the wall. The wall is being repointed as the previous repair had not been successful. Comments were raised by residents regarding the placing of skips and welfare facilities on the site which were felt to be inappropriate.

Christmas 2023 Forward Planning

Event going ahead on Friday 1st December and Public Entertainment Licence has been applied for. Tarbolton Parish Church organising Tea and Coffee in Erskine Hall. Other youth organisations to be contacted to ascertain whether they wish to participate in the event. Scouts have offered to carry out flyer distribution for the event. Tarbolton Bowling Club are planning their own event on a different evening.

Gala Day 2024

Suggested date of 1st June 2024. Separate committee to be formed comprising of Matthew McColm, Caroline Borland and Janet Thornton. Monkton Gala Committee have offered to provide guidance to the group as they have a very successful gala programme. Contact to be made to arrange meeting. Funding to help support the event to be sourced and additional assistance to be sought from other individuals.



Winter Gritting Resilience Group

Contact had been made by Ayrshire Roads Alliance in respect of the Community Resilience Scheme which offers support and training to all Community Councils who wish to participate in the scheme. The scheme provides all community council with hand operated footway spreaders, a grit bin, shovels and PPE to enable footway gritting activities to be carried out in the community. It was agreed that the Tarbolton Litter Group be contacted to ascertain if this is something they would consider participating in together with other volunteers in the Community. Contact to be made with them prior to deadline on Friday 13th October.

Any Other Competent Business

Tarbolton Landfill – Chairman advised he has had no response from SEPA to his recent emails. Councillor Dettbarn advising she would request an update from SAC. Any instances of river pollution should be reported direct to SEPA for action.

Tarbolton Town House – The garage and surrounding area has been sold. Purchaser is not known but could possibly be the owner of Smithfield Farm. Cllr Dettbarn to contact Estates to gather more information about this.

Litter Bins – the damaged to the bins was raised with Waste Management who have arranged for bins at the Cross, War Memorial and in Burns Street to be replaced with new bins due to disrepair. This has to be chased up and areas where SAC think there are litter bins to be investigated to ensure all bins are in situ.

Ms McCulloch and Ms Murdoch raised issue of vehicle speeds coming into the village as this is still an issue. Speed Reduction Measures still to be carried out. Follow up to be made with ARA about this.

Roadwork signs have not been uplifted from previous roadwork. Councillor Ferry to be provided of location of signage and he will contact SAC to arrange collection.
