Any Other Competent Business

Chairman reported that no further progress has been made by SEPA in relation to Tarbolton Landfill.

Public Transport – discussion regarding the number of buses which have been cancelled recently. Despite repeated complaints being made to Stagecoach the situation has not improved. Stagecoach have advised there is a lack of drivers, and they are having issues with the fleet of buses. Community Council recently shared contact details for complaints. Councillor Dettbarn advised she hadn't received any complaints despite this. Unsure whether any of the Elected Members had received complaints from residents. Community urged to continue to complain when service not provided.

Litter Bins – still not changed over. New bins are in stock however issue with removal of damaged bins due to the method of installation. Janet Thornton advised she would ask a local scrap metal dealer if he would remove the bins. Councillor Dettbarn offered to raise this with Waste Management. Secretary to discuss whether we can remove the bins with Waste Management to progress this matter.
